We all have a responsibility to promote high standard of behaviour in the game.

This club is supporting The FA Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.

Remember children football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

Play your part and observe The FA Respect Code of Conduct for spectator and parent /carer at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match official decisions
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectator Area (where provided)
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the player by telling them what to do
- Encourage the player to respect the opposition, referee and match official

Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake. Mistakes are part of learning

Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA, league or The FA.

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future game
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependent.

In addition:

The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club.
